

Creative Spelling Homework!



- Every week, try to complete 100 points worth of spelling activities.
- You can choose two 50 point activities or one 100 point activity.
- You may not complete the same activity two weeks in a row.
- Write which activities you have completed at the top of the page.

Fifty Point Choices!

- · Rainbow words: Copy your spellings at least three times in different colours.
- Draw your words: Draw and label each of your spellings.
- ABC words: Write your spellings in alphabetical order.
- Silly sentences: Write ten silly sentences using your spellings.
- Poem spelling: Write a poem using at least 5 of your spellings.
- Colourful words: Write your spellings with one colour for vowels and another for consonants.
- Backwards words: Write your spellings backwards e.g. where/erehw
- Bubble letters: Write your spellings in bubble writing.
- Squiggly spelling: Write your spellings normally and then in squiggly letters!
- Three times: First write your spelling in pencil, then use coloured pencil and finally
 use coloured pen.
- Riddle me: Write a riddle for each of your spellings e.g. Q: I cry when I am hungry and I am cute and cuddly. A: a baby.
- Rhyming words: Write a word that rhymes with each of your spellings.
- Secret agent words: Number the alphabet e.g. a=1, b=2 etc. and then write each of your spellings in number code.
- Across and down: Write each of your spellings across and then down the page.
- Type them: Type each of your spellings three times on to the computer using a different font and colour for each spelling.
- Vowel circle: Write each of your spellings and then circle each vowel in a different colour.

One Hundred Point Choices!

- Word search: Create a word search using all of your spellings. Ask someone at home to solve it!
- Story words: Write a short story using all of your spellings.
- Amazing advert: Write an TV or radio advert that includes all of your spellings.
- Cartoon words: Create a comic strip that includes all of your spellings.
- Sing it: Write a song or a rap that uses all of your spellings. Practise performing it so we can all hear!
- Wordle: Go to <u>www.wordle.net</u> and create a word cloud of your spellings.
- Hidden words: Draw and colour a picture. Hide your spelling words inside your picture.
- Dear dear: Write a letter to someone that uses all of your spellings.
- Code words: Come up with a code for each letter of the alphabet e.g.
- a = b = Then write your spellings in code.
- Sign your spellings: Go to http://www.unitykid.com/signlanguage.html and learn your spellings in sign language.
- Cheerleaders: Come up with a cheerleading chant for each of your spellings!
- Magazine words: Use an old magazine or newspaper. Cut out and stick the letters
 to make each of your spellings.
- 3D words: Use plasticine or play-doh to sculpt your spelling words.
- Classify your spellings: Write each of your spellings and write whether it is a noun, verb, adjective etc.
- Read all about it: Write a newspaper article using each of your spellings.
- Scrabble: Use Scrabble tiles to make each of your spellings. Work out the points value of each word.
- Synonym and antonym words: Write one word that has the same meaning as each
 of your spellings and another which has the opposite meaning.
- Invent and create: Come up with a new way to help you to learn your spellings! Be prepared to share your ideas with us all!
